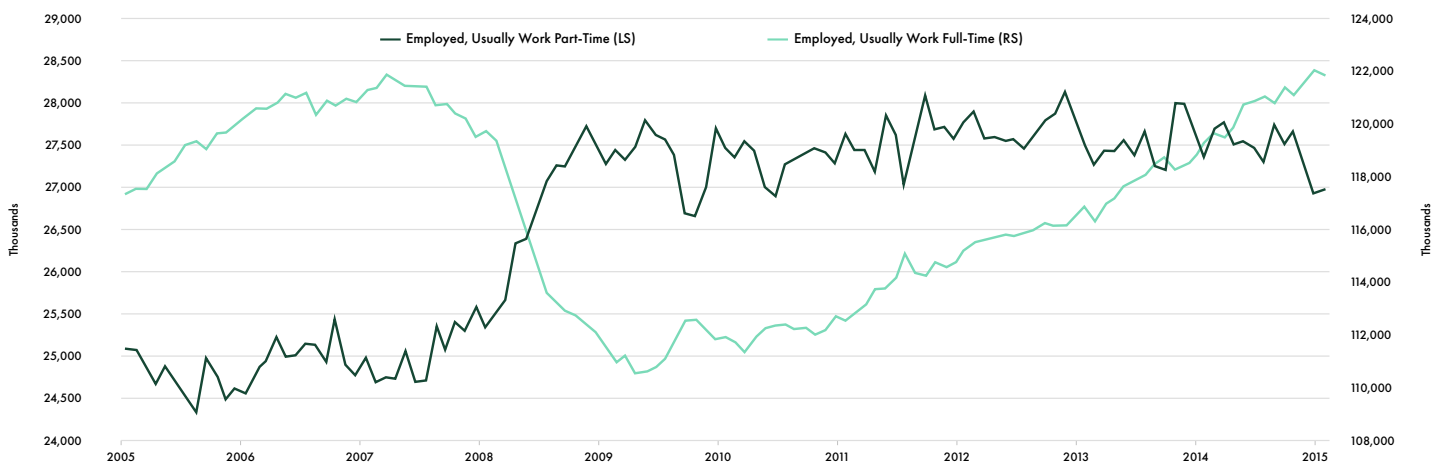
Candidate Selection
